Day 1 - Fly by Night Cookie Company, Fair Haven — pick up a cookie for the ride then take Cayuga Lake Scenic Byway south to Aurora. MacKenzie-Childs, Ltd in Aurora is a picturesque farm overlooking Cayuga Lake; see hand decorated ceramic tableware, Visitor Center & Gift Shop; then back north to Lake Ontario to visit the Heluva Good Cheese Country Store in Sodus before heading to the Waterloo Premium Outlets Mall. End the day at Pultneyville, a quaint lakeside hamlet with restaurant, art gallery and marina. Overnight at B&B.

Day 2 - Start the day at the Craft Antique Co-op with over 200 shops in West Greece. See quilt blocks painted on 40 barns in a loop off GLST Country Barn Quilt Trail that starts in Kendall at Partyka Farm. Stroll around Lewiston's picturesque downtown. Overnight in Youngstown or Lewiston.

Day 3 - Visit Buffalo's hip Elmwood Village or the Niagara Craft & Hobby Mart in Cheektowaga. Don't forget to checkout East Aurora for old Fashioned Vidler's 5&10 Cent Store and the Roycroft Campus. Overnight in East
